naturally boho look. Getting ready was fast and stress-free - find a quiet spot to get ready in and surround yourself with people who are professionals you trust and you'll be calm on your wedding day."

The groom's sister read from Ruth 1. 16-17 and the bride's younger brothers read 'These I Can Promise' by Mark Twain during the couple's religious, outdoor, olive grove ceremony in France. "We also had an all-female choir sing an acoustic, acapella version of Fatboy Slim's 'Praise You' during

the ceremony. In another twist, Alex and I decided to walk down the aisle and enter the ceremony together."

Both the ceremony and reception took place at Domaine Les Roullets in the South of France. "Our venue was in the middle of a beautiful vineyard in France," Tara explains. After the ceremony, guests were treated to live-cooked canapés that included flash-fried prawns, oysters and truffle macaroni cheese. "For the wedding breakfast, we had a sharing feast of beef

ribs and leg of lamb with a designated carver at each table, complete with personalised chef hat and apron!"

Inspired by their setting, Tara and Alex styled their wedding with a gentle touch, embracing the Provençal feel of their location. "Isabel & Ink worked collaboratively with artist Suzy Foster to create our stationery with French lavender florals and an illustration of our venue."

Floral designer, Canopea Design, suspended jars of flowers from the olive

trees surrounding the ceremony area, also creating huge floral arrangements to spill over logs and creating the bride's relaxed, French wildflower bouquet.

"We ate dinner beneath a canopy of festoon and fairy lights to create an atmosphere inspired by 'A Midsummer Night's Dream'." Be Lounge supplied the tent and furniture for the evening, which was decorated inside with lavender trees.

"A pastry chef from Villandry, who is also a great family friend of ours and was a guest on the day, spent two days before the wedding creating our five-tier, partially gluten-free naked cake."

With the feasting complete, the couple and their guests were ready to party. "Alex's company, ALR Music, ensured we had amazing entertainment for the big day. A live quartet led by Kate Threlfall played first, then the amazing 10-piece party band The Soul Jets played after dinner, followed by the brilliant DJ Charles, who played into the early hours. The next day, we hosted

a pool party, for which guests received personalised flip-flops, with a bloody Mary barbecue too."

After the weekend-long celebrations, Tara and Alex jetted off to Italy for a two-week minimoon in Positano, Capri and Tuscany. "It was a divine two weeks of delicious food, wine and relaxation.
